It is my honour, on behalf of Branch Chair Sarjit Manhas, to provide you with the Chair's Report from the Annual General meeting.

The meeting was opened with the traditional and respectful two minutes of silence for deceased members.

It makes me sad to report that another Branch has shut down. Branch 1300 North Okanagan ceased operations despite many attempts by the Provincial Executive to help out.

Major business was three resolutions. The first was to more clearly define the criteria to receive Honorary Membership and changed the name to "Honoured Members". The second resolution was to complete the motion asking for the Shingles Vaccination to be covered by Blue Cross. Both of these were Moved, Seconded and Carried. NOTE: One significant change this year is that cheques must be payable to "BC Government Retired Employees Association" written out in full. The letter abbreviation is not acceptable at the cheque clearing house.
