## 1. Call to Order, 1:30 pm

I would like to acknowledge that we gather here today on the traditional territory of the Snuneymuxw First Nation. There were 14 members present.

**Introduction of Guest Speaker:** 

Lea welcomed our guest speakers Marlene Bell, President of the Nanaimo Hospital Auxiliary and Laura Greig, 1st Vice President.

Formed in 1900 in Britain, there are 235 (20 men) volunteers in Nanaimo. All are unpaid. In 2024 they donated 54, 000 hours.

Nanaimo Bars were founded by the auxiliary in 1952. It has always been a fund raiser - the gift shop at hospital (45 years), doesn't make a lot of money but offers support. The Thrift Store (established in 2005) is the real money maker. They rely on community for donations. All items are reasonably priced. The store space is not large enough, so cannot take large appliances and furniture. Small appliances, books, good clothing and household linens are welcome donations. Non-Profit society. No longer under Island Health. Hospital volunteers are separate. Craft group makes jewelry, knit baby items, quilts, gifts for patients at Christmas. Clothing that cannot be used goes to Big Brothers/Big Sisters. In 2025 they will donate \$1,250,000 of essential equipment and services for the Nanaimo Hospital and the proposed Cancer Clinic.

Ice machines, blanket warmers, wheel chair bus for Dufferin Place, birthing bed, bed pan washer, bladder scans, ECG machines are some of the items purchased this year. They have set aside \$250,000 per year for the next five years for the cancer clinic.
