Branch Meetings:

Quesnel: The Branch held a meeting in Quesnel & District Seniors Centre **February 18**, where we discussed Pension/benefits and the 2.6% adjustment in January. Speakers from the North Cariboo Agricultural Marketing Assoc. gave a presentation on their incredible local food providers, food sustainability and their impact on the Cariboo economy.
