BLUEBERRY GINGERBREAD -BY KATHY TORHJELM, SECRETARY 9X13" pan, buttered. Preheat oven to 350°F.

Beat together in order: ½ cup oil; 1 cup sugar; ¼ cup molasses, 1 egg

Combine: (reserving 3 Tbsp)
2 cups flour; 1 tsp powdered ginger, 1 ½
tsp cinnamon, ½ tsp nutmeg, ¼ tsp
cloves, 1 tsp baking soda.

Add flour mixture and 1 cup buttermilk alternatively with molasses mixture, beginning and ending with flour. Fold in 2 cups frozen or fresh blueberries (dredged with 3 Tbsp reserved flour mixture). Pour into pan and bake for 45 to 50 mintues.

Lemon Glaze:

l cup water; ½ cup sugar, 3 Tbsp lemon juice; 2 tbsp cornstarch, 2 tsp grated lemon rind

Combine and heat until mixture thickens and comes to a boil. Remove from heat. Stir in ¼ cup butter until melted. Pour warm glaze over cake. Serve **warmmmmm** to 8 - 10 friends or family.
