Libraries Cooperative)—not only physical books, but e-books, audio books, e-magazines, and music. The Apps Hoopla and Libby allow for free movies as well.

Items can be downloaded onto various devices—laptops, tablets and cell phones. Once you have downloaded the 'item', it can be listened to or watched without an internet connection. There may be a wait time for current, popular books—but once requested, you go into a que (the same as when you put a physical book on hold). The loan period varies, but is generally 2 or 3 weeks. (Then it just disappears from your device.)

Library cards are free in BC—you just need to attend at your local library with identification and proof of your residential address.

The staff at the library can assist patrons with any questions that they have with regard to these very beneficial library programs.

This service is available through the Okanagan Regional Libraries as well as the Penticton Public Library—check out the 'Home Page' of your local library for more information. Paul Perkins reminded members that in some more remote areas one may have to find an internet "hot spot" to be able to access library books.

Following Imre's presentation the business meeting commenced.
